1. Call to Order

2. School Leader Report (Executive Director)

- **Academic Results:** Highlights: 8th grade ELA trending really strong, LE had over a 80% pass rate; Algebra over a 70% pass rate. Also received MAP scores great and they had strong growth scores compared to similar sized schools. Saw some bright spots in history and biology - will dive more into this next month
- **Enrollment:** Current enrollment is between **685–690 scholars**. The school remains below hedged enrollment due to Middle School numbers but is actively enrolling for the current and upcoming school years.
- **Talent:** Both High School and Middle School are currently **fully staffed**.
- **Facilities/Legal:** No change in status regarding the security deposit for 332 E 149th St; legal counsel is pursuing a court response.
- **Fund Development:** Got a grant for \$114,400.

3. Committee Reports

- **Academic Committee:**
 - Discussed HS January Regents Exams :
 - Moderate increase in proficiency in Jan
 - AP Gov went from 24- 54%
 - Algebra I most kids sat for it.
 - Missed some other stats
 - MS reviewed MAP growth and Math growth was not as strong. Sandy and Summer are sitting in on coaching meeting to better understand on execution.
 - AI Programs – looking into asking scholars and teachers how they would like to use it.
- **Finance Committee:**
 - Will be in April due to spring break and holidays.
- **Fund Development:**
 - Working on a list of potential funders – was shared with the board.
 - Have applied for a few grants.
- **Governance:**
 - Discussed board member resignations and nominating a new board member.
